

Access Statement for HARLOW INTERNATIONAL HOSTEL

Introduction

We aim to cater for the needs of all visitors in this 17 bed hostel, the old village shop in the centre of a beautiful town park. The following statement is a summary of our provision. If you have any specific questions about access, please contact us and we will endeavour to help. At this moment in time all our bedrooms are on the first floor and our stairs are not suitable for persons who can not walk unaided. Ground floor bedrooms with wheelchair access should be available late summer 2009.

Pre-Arrival

- Stansted Airport is only 12 miles away.
- Train links to London (Liverpool Street), Cambridge and Stansted Airport. Harlow Town rail station is only 800 metres walk from the hostel.
- Frequent bus services, bus stop 600 metres from hostel.
- Local taxi services have accessible taxis if required.

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

- Ample parking in large free car park 50 metres from hostel or in lane adjacent to hostel.
- Car park can be used by coaches and mini buses.
- Please provide advance notice if assistance is needed to move to and from vehicles.

Main Entrance, Reception & Ticketing Area

- Main entrance approached from a gentle, cobbled slope. A rear entrance is available if this is problematic.
- Single step into building.
- Seating available at Reception.
- Payphone available with adjacent seating.
- Emergency button to contact a member of staff (on site) at night.
